Bergman Academy offers enrichment classes to its students after school from 3:45-4:45 pm. We are pleased to offer the opportunity for students to participate in engaging classes that further stimulate their learning, passions, and experiences. Our carefully planned enrichments include a wide variety of topics, from outdoor adventures and cooking to yoga and chess. Students have the opportunity to collaborate with peers of different ages and to interact with a variety of adult teaching staff. As a result, some of our clubs available to preschool and pre-kindergarten age children are separate from our DHS certified preschool curriculum. Enrichment courses are offered seasonally, with new courses and registration beginning each fall, winter and spring.

Cost

Enrichment classes cost \$125 for 8-week sessions, \$110 for 7-week sessions, and \$95 for 6-week sessions. This can be billed to your monthly invoice or paid directly to Bergman Academy.

Students are encouraged to pack a healthy snack each afternoon. They'll have time between 3:30-3:45 p.m. to enjoy their snack.

Cancelled Classes

There are no enrichments on the following days:

Cancelled classes will be made up based on instructor availability and space starting Monday, February 3rd through Friday, February 7th.

Enrollment

Minimum and maximum class enrollment numbers may apply to certain enrichments. Bergman Academy reserves the right to cancel any program due to lack of sufficient participation. Due to the registration format, there is a chance you'll be able to register for a club that has already met its maximum. If this is the case, you will receive an email within 24 hours letting you know that the club is full. If you don't receive an email, then your registration is complete. If the club you are trying to register for does not show up on the registration form, it is already full and no longer accepting members.

Confirmation emails will be sent on November 11th.

Pick-up Policy

Students will be dismissed at 4:45 out the front doors, to be picked up at the entrance of the school or in car line. Instructors remain with their students until 4:50, and all students not picked up will then join the After Care program. Families will be billed \$5 (half the cost of the full afternoon of care).

Late Registration Policy

Registrations submitted after the stated registration deadline will be charged a fee of \$10 per enrichment club.

Cancellation Policy

Our instructors are extremely dedicated to the enrichment program at Bergman Academy. They spend a lot of time preparing and planning for their clubs. Due to their hard work and preparation, we will be enforcing a cancellation policy this year. Cancellations made 10 days or more in advance of the enrichment session start date, will receive a 100% refund. Cancellations made within 3-9 days will incur a \$50 fee. Cancellations made within 48 hours of the enrichment session start date will be charged full price.

Level 1 Chess Club

Grades 1-2

Instructors: Katie Freerksen and Bill Broich

4 minimum/12 maximum

No previous chess experience is required, but preparation is encouraged. First time students will master the rules of chess, piece movement and chess terms. Returning students will work on mastering piece movement, learning check mating strategies and basic piece development goals. In Level 1 we work on the basics of chess while helping the students to understand focus, sportsmanship, respect for their opponents, and that losing is an opportunity to learn. Students who are able to attend Level 1 for multiple sessions will gain the ability to teach others the rules of chess and will have the opportunity to learn how to record their games with algebraic notation. Students will receive a Gold ChessKid.com membership.

Level 2 Chess Club

Grades 3-8

Instructors: Jim Freerksen and Bill Broich

4 minimum/20 maximum

Students must have a basic understanding of Level 1 chess skills**. In Level 2 students will learn tactics, openings, pawn structure, and common endgames while reinforcing and expanding on their Level 1 knowledge. Students in Level 2 will also develop transferable life skills such as self-discipline, concentration, long term planning, and the ability to learn from their mistakes. Students will receive a Gold ChessKid.com membership.

Yoga and Movement Grades K-5

10 minimum/32 maximum

Ms. John is a certified Yoga Instructor (CYT200) and is excited to partner with Ms. Havemann to bring an amazing yoga opportunity to our students. We will help students move and embrace healthy mental awareness. With continued efforts to improve mental health and wellness in our society, yoga is a proven practice students should instill into their lifetime routines. Fridays are a welcome end, even for a child's fun school week and we are excited to help students learn how and why to recharge through Yoga and Movement! Paired with healthy habits, children will have the foundation to be mindful and active!

Martial Arts and Karate Grades K-6

Instructor: Phil Dickey
15 minimum/30 maximum

In this class, students will learn the tenets of courtesy, integrity, perseverance, self-control and indomitable spirit, and situational application of them as well. Martial arts techniques focus on life protection, covering, punching, kicking, escapes from grabs, chokes, and how to apply these techniques to stand up to both verbal and physical attacks, bullying, and various situations in the most non-violent way possible. The instructor has been a school teacher for 28 years, so age appropriate instruction is applied. At the end of each session the student, if ready, will test for their next rank. The instructor is a three-time Martial Arts Hall of Fame inductee and has had 37 years of martial arts experience, having owned his martial arts business for 34 years.

Odyssey of the Mind Grades 4-5

5 minimum/7 minimum

Odyssey of the Mind, abbreviated OM or OotM, is a creative problem-solving program involving students and promoting teamwork and creativity. Team members work together at length to solve a predefined long-term problem and present their solution to the problem at a spring state competition. State winners will have the option of participating in the Odyssey of the Mind World Finals.
